**RESIDENCIES and AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS:** Designed series of classes to fit your needs conducted by trained teaching artists. Residencies can be provided during school hours or after school to facilitate the drama portion of your activities weekly or for the whole year! Dates flexible.

**TELL ME A STORY TO GO:** A dramatized story with interactive elements touring to **K3-K5 classrooms/preschools.** One of our Teaching Artists brings her high energy and child-friendly interpretation of favorite children's stories to your kids. It's sure to be a great literacy connection and a sweet treat for your students, right in your own classroom. The material will likely include audience participation segments or simple audience interaction and will last no longer than 30 minutes – perfect for young, wiggly patrons.
